



Stosh – Polish Pilsner – 5.5% ABV – 28 IBU

A maltier, “wetter” pilsner typical of Poland with a subdued bitterness, earthy floral notes at the finish.

Goldblatz – Golden Ale – 5.5% ABV – 15 IBUs

Light-to-medium bodied, crisp and mildly fruity and is sure to become as familiar with Regionites as the classic film, *A Christmas Story*, based on Jean Shepherd’s roots.

Orange is the new Wheat – Orange Wheat – 5% ABV – 20 IBUs *this beer has lactose*

Crisp and refreshing with the equivalent of 120 oranges per barrel in this hazy wheat beer.

Apricot Wheat – Apricot Witbier – 4.8% ABV – 10 IBUs

Golden peach in color with haze from wheat and yeast. Aroma is strong with apricot, berries, and spicy Belgium yeast. A residual sweetness balances the tart apricot flavor, finishing clean with a slight tartness.

Number Six – Hefeweizen – 5% ABV – 12 IBUs

Just like Number Six, this beer is tall, blonde, and beautiful! The word hefeweizen translates as “yeast wheat” in German. Brewed with 50% wheat and fermented with a Bavarian style yeast. It has an appealing nose with hints of banana, clove, vanilla, and bubblegum. The flavor of wheat is blended with a touch of bubblegum.

Red Buck – Belgo Red Ale – 7% ABV – 38 IBUs

Medium-bodied ruby red ale with stone fruit, plum, and fig aromas balanced with Citra, Mosaic, and Simco hops. Maltiness blends with sweet dried fruit and hints of citrus hop flavors with a pleasant hop bitterness.

Rare Eagle – White Stout w/ coffee and chocolate – 7% ABV – 30 IBUs

This white stout is infused with a blonde espresso roast, followed by layers of chocolate with a creamy finish due to the addition of milk sugars.

Shinobi – Export Stout – 6% ABV – 35 IBUs

Deep roasted coffee/dark chocolate nose. Blackish brown in color with a firm hazel crown of foam. Medium bodied with flavors of espresso, dark chocolate and sweet roasted malt. Finishing with a notable yet balanced roasted malt/hop bitterness.

Mango Jammer – Mango Milkshake IPA – 5.5% ABV – 35 IBUs

Sweet Mango, Madagascar Vanilla, and a slight bitterness on the backend. Oh Yeah!!

Cambrian Explosion – Hazy IPA – 6% ABV – 35 IBUs

Powerful hop aroma resembling citrus, tropical, and passion fruit. Light straw in color with an apparent haze contributed by the additions of wheat and oats to the beer. The mouthfeel is light with a mild pillowy texture, mild malt flavors are overwhelmed by the hop flavors of citrus and tropical.

Assuage the Anguish – Double IPA – 9% ABV – 85 IBUs

Want to revisit hop bitterness the craft beer renaissance was based on? This DIPa is a spin on a classic west coast style IPA. It’s golden straw in color and boasting with a rich, malty nose complemented by Citra, Amarillo, and New Zealand Cascade hops. The flavor is rich yet slightly drying with hop bitterness dominating the overall profile.

Orange/Cranberry Sour – Wild Ale – 4.7% ABV – 10 IBUs

Tart and refreshing with a mild funk and fruitiness. Perfect on a hot Summer day.
